







Executive Summary

The evolution of the complex scenario concerning the different aspects of Security is reflected by the attention and interest of a growing audience of academic and industrial researchers towards **SERIT** (Security Research in Italy – www.piattaformaserit.it), *the Italian technological platform acting in security which gathers today more than 300 organizations* and an increasing number of security experts that participate in all its activities.

SERIT, a joint initiative launched by CNR and Finmeccanica, brings together Italian industries (both large industries and SMEs), academia, research centers and end-users, in order to promote and develop a <u>National Research Agenda</u> to drive the future technological developments, while answering to the identified National Security needs. To this aim, SERIT has been originally structured in <u>Leading-Sectors</u> (representing the different area where Security needs to be investigated in Italy) and <u>Technological Areas</u> (identifying the technological priorities). Within this role, SERIT aims to reinforce the networking among national researchers, industries, end-users and institution's representatives, allowing them to cooperate on common interest projects, to activate public-private partnerships and to strengthen national and international participation to research programs (including National research/national cluster activities and Horizon 2020).

The Technological Areas, that describe the key capabilities and technologies to be developed, are listed below:

- TA 1 Surveillance & Situational Awareness;
- TA2 Communications;
- TA3 Detection & Identification Systems;
- TA4 Technology for Crisis Management and Protection of Persons, Asset and Infrastructure;
- TA5 Information Processing and Management;
- TA6 CBRNE (Chemical Biological, Radiological, Nuclear and Explosives).

A Transversal Area, TA7 "Legal and Ethical Issues of Security", was also created with the aim of analyzing the ethical and social aspects of security applications.

- SG3 Border Security
- SG4 Cyber Security
- SG5 Food Safety and Security
